Route Characteristics

- ♦ Minimal freeway riding, city streets and short segments of modestly twisty roads.
- ♦♦ Some freeway riding and some twisty back roads (up to 175 miles).
- ♦♦♦ Moderate distances on freeways and/or lengthy segments of significantly twisty back roads (150-275 mi.)
- ♦♦♦♦ Significant distances (250-500 miles per day) on freeways and/or extremely twisty, steep, and mountainous roads.
- ♦♦♦♦♦ Significant distances (500 -1000 miles per day) on freeways and/or twisty, steep mountainous roads.
- LRR Long Range Rides with minimal breaks for food and no road captain support.
- **MR** Meet-up ride. Meet at a designated location and ride to another location, group ride or event. No road captain support. **Destination Ride**: One-way ride that ends as soon as you arrive at the destination or starting point of a larger group ride.
